Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct outlines the responsibilities of any person visiting the UUCGV property, both inside and outside. We welcome you here! Thank you for respecting this Code of Conduct.

Below is a list of expectations of all people while visiting our property:

- 1. **Smoking:** No smoking or vaping in the building or within 20 feet of doors.
- 2. Alcohol: Alcohol use is limited to special events and must be pre-authorized in the Facility Rental Agreement.
- 3. **Drugs:** Use of illegal drugs, or disruptive behavior due to substance use, is prohibited.
- 4. **Camping:** Camping overnight is prohibited.
- 5. Loitering: Spending time on the property without purpose or permission is prohibited.
- 6. **Bathrooms:** Urinating or defecating outside of a bathroom is cause for immediate property ban and no trespassing notification. There are two public outdoor toilets on the property, available 24/7 to the community. Please use these respectfully.
- 7. Fires: No fires are allowed anywhere on the property.
- 8. **Blessing Box:** Guests are welcome to give or receive from the Blessing Box at any time. Please only take what is needed, so that others may also be blessed by the generosity of the community. Please only donate useful/clean items and refrain from bringing broken/dirty items.
- 9. Vandalism: Intentional damage of any kind, to any part of the property, is considered vandalism.
- 10. Harassment: Harassment is unwelcome verbal, written, physical, or sexual conduct. Harassment of UUCGV staff, congregants, volunteers, tenants, or other guests is prohibited and will result in being banned from the property
- 11. **Violence:** Any physical aggression toward another person or animal is prohibited and will result in being banned from the property

Below is a list of consequences for not observing this Code of Conduct:

- 1. **Banning from the property:** You will no longer be allowed on the premises. Depending on the severity of the grievance, this may be permanent, or for a specific time period. Being banned removes your ability to access any programming on the property. You may or may not be able to be escorted onto the property to access some services. Once banned, this privilege will be determined on a case by case basis but will not be guaranteed.
- 2. **No Trespass Order:** This is a formal serving of a no trespassing order from the GJPD. Once served, any infractions will result in the police being called to escort you off the property.
